The Home was set up in the year 2001 to provide residential care and cure support with counseling and vocational training to 60 mentally ill women.

Project Objectives

- To provide short and medium term psychosocial and occupational therapy to mentally ill women
- To extend rehabilitation support to the poor rural women.
- To educate the rural people on mental illness.

Major Activities Accomplished

☐ New Admission and discharge:

- We have newly admitted 08 mentally ill women in our Dominique Lapierre Home for Mentally ill Women to provide comprehensive residential care and cure services.
- 15 number of beneficiaries were rehabilitated to their normal life and sent back to their family.



▣ Celebration of Auspicious Day

During that period we along with our beneficiaries celebrated auspicious days like Rabindranath Tagore's birthday with great joy and enthusiasm. Moreover, on the eve of World Environment day the boarders of the residential home planted trees in their premises to make green world.



□ **Vocational Training:**

According to their interest 28 women are receiving vocational training on stitching dress materials from qualified teacher.
